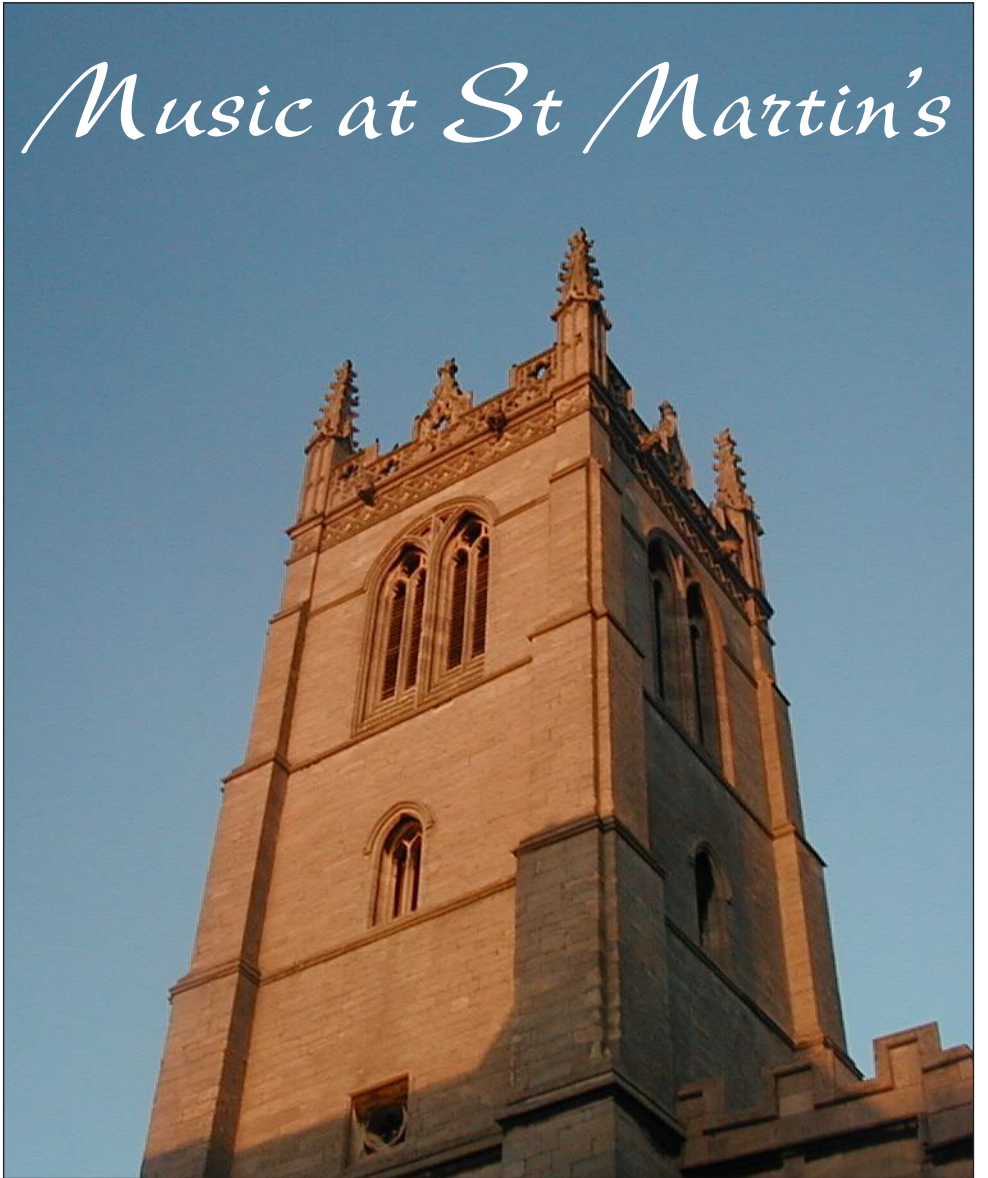

# Music at St Martin's

**Joint Presidents: Orlando and Miranda Rock**

The organisation is making an application to the Charity Commission to register as a Charity.

Our objective<sup>1</sup> is to raise funds for the maintenance and repair of the church (built over 500 years ago). In 2007 we donated £2,000. We do this by promoting about ten concerts a year, mostly at St Martin's itself.

We wish, as part of our drive to become a more substantial promoter, to establish a membership, to support the aims of the organisation, and to vote for a management committee to run it at an Annual General Meeting. It's not all obligation, however: we would be pleased to offer our members a pair of tickets to an event each year.

There are two options for joining, either as an individual or a couple:

## Individual

- One vote at AGM
- Ticket to an event of your choice

**Subscription: £20 per annum**

## Couples and Families

- Two votes at AGM
- Two tickets to an event of your choice<sup>2</sup>

**Subscription: £30 per annum**

<sup>2</sup>(*accompanied children of school age can attend most concerts free of charge*)

You can pay by Standing Order or by Cheque. We would prefer a Standing Order: please complete all sections of the form opposite.

If you are a taxpayer and complete the Gift Aid declaration, we may be able to recover tax paid on your contribution. You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donations in the appropriate tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).

Alternatively, please send a cheque with a covering note, including all your contact details, and, preferably the Gift Aid Declaration opposite.

**Corporate:** A separate non-voting scheme is available for companies, with a variety of levels of donation. Please ask for details.
